




In 1957 when Don and Phil Everly released their first number one hit single "Bye Bye Love" they became a mainstay of the 1950's and 1960's pop music era, with big hits such as "Cathy's Clown", "Bird Dog", "Lucille", "Wake Up Little Susie", "All I have To Do Is Dream", "Let It Be Me" and "(Til) I Kissed You" to name just a few.

The Everly Brothers songs were influenced by country and rockabilly music, and they combined those roots with their signature harmonies to create a new sound that

influenced The Beatles, The Rolling Stones and many more musicians; their legacy was formally recognized when the brothers were voted into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame in 1986, and the Country Music Hall of Fame in 2001.

This 2 disc DVD set, **The Everly Brothers - "Harmonies from Heaven"** features the documentary produced by BBC4 that focused on the brother's music during the 1950's and 1960's. From their time performing on their dad's radio show to when they created a sound that would go on to



define what great harmonies meant in modern music-it's all here on the first disc. I saw the original broadcast of this doc and what I especially liked about this set was the inclusion of interview footage that didn't make the first cut. However, things were not always rosy for the duo-they parted ways more than once, releasing their last studio album in 1988. The Everly Brothers did tour and record with other artists; sadly Phil

Everly passed away 6 years ago, and the book closed forever on The Everly Brothers as a duo.

Disc 2 of this set is a real treat, featuring a rare live performance from a television show that was taped in Australia in 1968. What I

liked about this concert (beside the great songs) is the fact that the concert

was not colored, or touched up-it has that great original archive-quality black and white look, which adds to the authenticity, and right from the start with the song "Lucille" you see just how rock and roll the boys really were. The live tracks are "Lucille", "Walk Right Back", "Susie Q", "Wake Up Little Susie", "Cathy's Clown", "All I Have To Do Is Dream", "Bye Bye Love", "So Sad", "Bowling Green", "(Til) I Kissed You", "Bird Dog", "Let It Be Me", "Be-Bop-A-Lula" and "Kentucky". This collection chronicles a vital part of rock and roll history that should not be missed.

TAX TIPS COLUMN

TAX TIPS FOR THE SINGLE PARENT

ELIGIBLE DEPENDENTS - : Single parents are allowed to claim the \$11,635 amount for an eligible dependent (sometimes referred to as equivalent to spouse) for one of their children. You have to support your child in a dwelling which you live in and maintain.

JOINT CUSTODY - : If there are two children and the parents share joint custody, then each parent can claim the equivalent to spouse amount for one child. But if you pay child support, you cannot claim this credit.

CANADA CHILD BENEFIT - The basic benefit is \$6,496 for a child under six and \$5,481 for a child aged six to 17. However, the amount you receive is also calculated by reference to your household income. If you earn more than \$30,450, the amount you receive will be reduced. An additional reduction kicks in when your net income exceeds \$65,975.

CHILD SUPPORT - If your agreement is dated after May 1, 1997 then child support payments are neither taxable to you nor deductible to your ex spouse although you do need to report them on your tax return.

CHILD CARE - : Child care expenses can add up but you must have receipts from your daycare or babysitter. If you are paying a family member to look after your children, this can be claimed as long as they are 18 or over and provide a receipt with their SIN. They will also need to report this income on their tax return.

CHANGING STATUS - : If you move in with the other parent of your child, you are considered common law for tax purposes straight away. If you move in with someone else, you are only considered common law after you have lived together for a year. If you get married or become common law, you need to report the change to the Canada Revenue Agency using a RC65 Form. This will affect your ability to claim the equivalent to spouse amount as well as your Child Tax Benefit calculation.

CLAIMING DEPENDENTS - : Once a child turns 18, they are no longer considered a dependent for tax purposes even if you continue to support them. The only exception is infirm children. Unused tuition credits can also still be transferred to a parent, even if the student is older than 18
