



What Is The Future Of The Cape Breton Exhibition?

CBC's Information Morning recorded an interview with Donnie MacNeil who is head of the Cape Breton Exhibition Society.

The Society recently submitted a proposal to the Board of Directors of the Cape Breton Agriculture to purchase the Exhibition Grounds but was turned down.

The Board decided to list the Exhibition Grounds with a local realtor.

The goal of the proposal was to maintain the facility as a community asset and continue the tradition of using the facilities for local events and the Annual Exhibition which averaged 15,000 visitors each year.

If the Grounds are sold as a commercial adventure to a development group, the loss would be significant as there would be no more harness racing, annual Exhibition or the many community events sponsored each year the the current facilities.

Donnie MacNeil feels his group would keep the tradition that community groups have built over the years.

The loss to the community would be a cultural one as well as a financial one. Time is of the essence if any group wants to salvage this year's events schedule.

I encourage you to listen to the CBC Podcast and hear the whole story behind the group's proposal. It would be a shame to lose the Exhibition grounds to a land developer.

For this week's column we're taking a musical journey to Port Aux Basques, Newfoundland-home of singer/songwriter Randy Matthews, and this, "Nothing More", is his latest album. All you need to do is check out any of Randy's online videos and you'll see and hear a seasoned performer who started out at 15-and had soon released 2 albums, with this one being his third. I generally don't consider myself a 'new country' music fan, preferring old style Country & Western, so when I read that Randy cited Johnny Cash, Waylon Jennings and Chris Stapleton as influences I was definitely interested in hearing the numbers on this CD. The album opens with the song "Driving Me Crazy" and right away you know you're listening to something fresh and original-a song that's heads and tails above some of the 'pop music with cowboy hats' dominating Country radio here in the Atlantic Provinces. The song "Lessons" has a nice light do-SE-do vibe to it, and the honkytonk vibe on the humorous "Weed Over Wine" adds a nice touch to the number. A smokier bluesy groove propels "Treat Me Right" along quite nicely, and "Don't Give A



Damn" is a real live country kicker that packs a lot of punch. Randy considers Newfoundland traditional legend Roy Payne his biggest local influence and Randy's cover of Roy's "Old Hank" is right on the mark; it's great to hear songs by the old ones brought back to life. The album's namesake song, "Nothing More", really carries a heartfelt old-school Country feel, as Randy gets a great steel guitar backing by Dale Rivard. I can imagine wedding couples picking this as their first song. Also joining Randy on this album are Dave Fitzpatrick (drums, bass, guitars, harmonica, piano), Jordan Goudie (Guitar) and Luke Welsh (fiddle). Without mentioning every song here suffice it to say that Randy Matthews offers fans of real Country music a breath of fresh air, with some heart and soul as well. SENIORS CARE GRANT

The Seniors Care Grant provides financial support to low-to-modest income seniors to help them stay in their homes.

The Grant is an annual grant program to reimburse costs up to \$500 to help cover costs of household services.

It can be used to cover the costs of such things as snow removal, home repairs, lawn care, grocery delivery and more. It is available to homeowners and renters.

To be eligible for this grant:

- * You still reside in your home
- * The property or lease agreement is in your name or includes your name.
- * You are 65 years of age or over
- * You have an annual household net income of \$37,500 or less

TAX TIPS

Medical Expense Tax Credit

Note Line 33099 was Line 330 prior to 2019, and Line 58689 was Line 5868.

Income Tax Act s. 118.2(1)

A taxpayer can claim a non-refundable tax credit for medical expenses paid by the taxpayer or the taxpayer's spouse or common-law partner. The medical expenses claimable include those paid for the taxpayer, the taxpayer's spouse or common-law partner or a child under 18 of the taxpayer or spouse, who is dependent on the taxpayer or spouse for support.

There is a separate calculation for the medical expense tax credit for other eligible dependents, but see the comments below re the 12-month time period.

Generally, all eligible medical expenses can be claimed, even if they were incurred outside of Canada. When medical expenses are reimbursed by an insurance plan, only the portion not reimbursed can be claimed.

12 Month Time Period for Medical Expenses

Medical expenses can be claimed if they were paid within any 12 month period ending in the current tax year, and not claimed in the prior tax year. This is the only criteria for the time period for the expenses. The federal and provincial medical expenses claimed must be claimed for the same time period, as must medical expenses for other eligible dependants.



THE BLUEBERRY WARS

I can remember vividly each Summer during the blueberry picking season what we came to refer to as "The Blueberry Wars". Blueberries were a very popular commodity and the mothers used to make blueberry pie, blueberry cake, blueberry grunt, blueberry jam, blueberry muffins and just about anything else blueberries could be crammed into.

The boys would pick blueberries and when we tried to sell them in our neighbourhood, the mothers would argue like they were in a Turkish bazaar and we usually ended up with very little for our pickings. But that was just amateur stuff. The real pros were two rivals who originally came to Cape Breton via Holland. They lived near Dutch Brook and came to town to sell produce all summer.

The two would come to the neighbourhood and set up a little produce wagon and paint a sign with the prices listed. Just like clockwork, a rival seller would show up, take one look at the price and paint a number lower than his competitor. This would prompt an immediate response and the original seller would then reduce his price. This went on for ½ an hour and the whole neighbourhood would show up and watch the spectacle.

Eventually one of the sellers would leave in disgust and the winner would sell out all his produce at the "sale price". The mothers all thought they were getting a great bargain. What we did not know until they retired, was that the two sellers were the VanDeusen brothers and their little bit of theatre was all a stage performance and a great sales technique.

We eventually found out that at different parts and times in our town the brothers would act as "winner" and "loser" and would always go home with their carts empty having sold all their produce. When interviewed for a local news story, the brothers claimed that it was a great way to put on a little entertainment and make everybody feel good. They would say in their stilted English, "Iz gud for bizness."

They were excellent produce sellers but also very astute salesmen with a great grasp of human nature.
