





They were referring to the commercial fishery but the Minister was quick to point out that the recreational fishery was still open for the coming year.



It was a great relief to many local fishermen who enjoy the mackerel fishery all Summer Long.

Federal Fisheries Minister Joyce Murray announced Wednesday there will be no commercial or bait fishing for herring in the Gulf of St.


Lawrence and Atlantic mackerel in Atlantic Canada and Quebec.

The Department of Fisheries and Oceans (DFO) said urgent action had to be taken to give the stocks a chance to recover and to ensure the long-term sustainability and prosperity of East Coast fisheries.

The recreational fishery for mackerel will also remain open, but the daily limit of 20 mackerel that was put into place last year will remain.

I originally wrote a different column for this week but the recent tragic passing of Taylor Hawkins (the drummer for the Foo Fighters) made this one more relevant and timely. "Studio 666" is a comedy horror movie that stars the entire Foo Fighters band; Dave Grohl, Nate Mendel, Pat Smear, Rami Jaffee, Chris Shiflett and Taylor Hawkins (in his final film appearance) and tells the fictional story of the band basically being coerced into recording a new album at a mansion where unbeknownst to them a mass murder was committed involving, you guessed it, another band who was doing the same thing back in 1993-a band named Dream Widow .

The Foo Fighters manager (played by a very familiar actor) argues that this is the only way to get past Grohl's writers block and lay down some new tracks (even though he's fully aware of the location's nefarious history). Things quickly go from bad to worse as the haunted mansion and the malevolent spirits turn the recording sessions into a musical bloodbath-with only 1 Foo Fighter left at the end (sorry, no spoilers here). To be honest this movie is very tongue-in-cheek, kind of dumb and is borderline schlock horror-but it also pays homage to many schlock rock and horror films of yesteryear. It's meant to be a fun



ride for the viewer and something that never takes itself too seriously. The movie has some great cameos from Kerry King of Slayer, horror master John Carpenter, Jeff Garlin ("The Goldbergs"), comedian Whitney Cummings, Will Forte, and even Lionel Richie drops by. Directed by BJ McDonnell and written by Jeff Buhler and Rebecca Hughes, it's based on a story Dave Grohl came up with.

The horror effects are pretty well done, the live music segments are great and the band-members are actually decent actors. This is also the first non-documentary film featuring the band-and sadly enough, it will be the last one. With that being the case it's touching to see Taylor doing what he loved to do best-with the band he loved the most. According to Grohl, the band recorded a whole album for the in-movie fictional band Dream Widow.

The album was released last week. More on that in an upcoming edition of "Take 2". Enjoy!

SENIORS CARE GRANT

The Seniors Care Grant provides financial support to low-to-modest income seniors to help them stay in their homes.

The Grant is an annual grant program to reimburse costs up to \$500 to help cover costs of household services.

It can be used to cover the costs of such things as snow removal, home repairs, lawn care, grocery delivery and more. It is available to homeowners and renters.

To be eligible for this grant:

- * You still reside in your home
- * The property or lease agreement is in your name or includes your name.
- * You are 65 years of age or over
- * You have an annual household net income of \$37,500 or less

TAX TIPS

Tax Myths You Should Know

MYTH #1: If you receive a refund or Notice of Assessment (NOA) after filing, it means you won't be hearing from the government about this return again.

Many Canadians believe that the moment they file their return is the moment they can stop thinking about taxes for another year. Unfortunately, that's not the case. In fact, a filed return can still be assessed a number of times by either the Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) or Revenu Québec to make sure it's accurate. Be sure to keep all your documents for at least 6 years.

MYTH #2: You don't have to worry about information slips that were mailed to the wrong address. No matter where they're sent, you're responsible for your information slips. If you forget to report your information slips twice in a 4 year period, you'll face penalties, and your return will be audited

MYTH #3: If you worked outside of Canada, you don't have to file a Canadian return. If you went to school or worked outside of the country but you have significant residential ties to Canada (such as a home, spouse, or dependants in Canada), you'll need to file a Canadian return. Even if you don't have significant ties, you might still need to file a Canadian return if you have a lot of secondary residential ties.

MYTH #4: If you earned less than \$10,000, you don't have to file a return. If you're not reporting much income this year (or even none at all), you should still file a return. Filing your return means getting access to great federal and provincial benefits. Check out this blog to learn more about why you should file your return if you earned a small amount of income.

MYTH #5 - Tips aren't taxable. One of the most common tax mistakes is not accounting for all the cash you earned (that's right, tips are taxable!).

If you're working in the hospitality industry or get tips through your side gig, make sure you record what you earn and report it on your return.



Print Services Return To North Sydney

Long-time print shop operator, Peter Philips, thought he had retired from the industry for good when the family business, Northside Printers, closed in 2018. As fate would have it, retirement turned into a brief hiatus.

On the other side of Kelly's Mountain, Andrew Brooks had started Breton Print in the Village of Baddeck and was looking for someone to teach him the ropes.

"I have a background in business, writing, photography, and graphic design, but I knew nothing about running a print shop four years ago," said Brooks. "When Peter became a 'free agent', I wondered if he still wanted to be in the game. Fortunately, he did."



Peter joined Breton Print while it was still located in Baddeck. Last year, the company got into the large-format sector (signs, banners, wall graphics, canvas prints) and needed more production space. In July, they relocated to Court Street in what was once the old Jabalee's warehouse.
