PAUL POWER

This week I'm going bananas, letting the primates take over-with The Monkees album 'Good Times!' The Monkees released this album to mark the band's 50th anniversary in 2016 and it featured all three surviving band members: Micky Dolenz, Michael Nesmith, and Peter Tork. The album starts with the title song and it's as if it was written in 1966, calling up images of bell-bottoms, paisley shirts, crochet vests and groovy go-go dancers. The track 'Me and Magdelana' has a subtle and laid-back tone; sounding like Blue Rodeo meets The Cowboy Junkies meets The Tragically Hip. As for some of the other songs, 'Wasn't Born To Follow' is absolutely mesmerizing-bringing to mind Jeff Lynne's (ELO) best works, and 'I Know What I Know' is truly captivating with its lyrical wisdom. The best song here is 'Birth of an Accidental Hipster', which was written by 2 of my favourite artists, Paul Weller (The Jam/The Style Council) and Noel Gallagher (Oasis); it sounds so much like a



Beatles number it's uncanny. That 'Fab Four' vibe also pops up on the songs 'Our Own World', 'Gotta Give It Time' and 'Little Girl', which sounds like a Ringo Starr song. In their day The Monkees were often unflatteringly referred to as "The Prefab Four" and never got the musical credit they deserved because of all the wackiness surrounding their television series, and that whole time the band just wanted to show the world that they were real musicians. With this release, The Monkees delighted fans and proved their mettle as real musicians that should be taken seriously. I really like this album and I know a lot of other people will. Just be careful though, these songs are so darn catchy that you might find yourself swinging from a tree as you sing along.

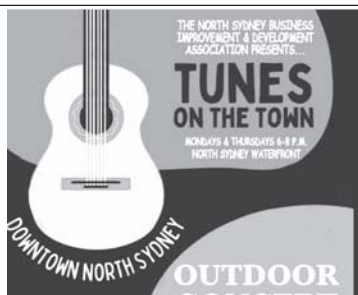
