





I subscribe to the excellent Canadian magazine Rue Morgue ("Horror in Culture and Entertainment") and when they did a cover story on the latest in the 'Final Destination' franchise-'Final Destination Bloodlines' it caught my interest. It's the sixth movie in the line and it's natural to question how can they find a new take on the whole concept. Well, they did. I'm not going to give too much away here but just as one of the previous films caused me to never look at a logging truck on the road the same way again this one did just that for engagement rings. 


