I always say that once a Metalhead always a Metalhead. Sure I listen to different genres of music but since my early teens Heavy Metal has always been in my blood-a tried and true friend. I believe most Metalheads are the same. An interesting thing happened not long after the New Wave Of British Heavy Metal (NWOBHM) hit our shores in the late 1970's and early 1980's; more metal bands began to lean towards more pop-influenced hooks and guitar riffs, upbeat rock anthems and especially slow power ballads. They borrowed heavily from the fashion and image of 1970s glam rock. Thus-'Hair Metal' was born. Ironically, many of them still kept a hard edge on some songs. Motley Crue, Bon Jovi, Poison, Def Leppard, Whitesnake, Van Halen, Twisted Sister, Kiss and even Guns N' Roses were sometimes classified as Hair Metal. To that end, Canadian musician and author Sean Kelly wrote this amazing book,



'Don't Call It Hair Metal', a detailed history of how it all started, what happened during it-and what, in a sense, ended it all (or did it?). One band here (Kix) described how right in the middle of a music video shoot they were told to shut it down, it was over. In general I wasn't a fan of the whole Grunge movement; to me it was just a bunch of navel-gazing, angst ridden junkies making noise (and Nirvana was the poster boys) but they all started a feeding frenzy among the record labels to find the next Nirvana or Pearl Jam. In the process said labels turned their backs on hair metal, and metal in general. But the phoenix rose from the ashes and Heavy Metal still rules supreme.

HEAVY GARBAGE COLLECTION APRIL 28

MATERIAL ACCEPTED FOR HEAVY GARBAGE COLLECTION - Bulky, Heavy or large items: Sofas, chairs, upholstered furniture, mattresses, box springs, carpeting, flooring, vinyl windows or vinyl doors will be collected.

Panes of glass from windows should be removed. Collectors are not responsible for cleaning up broken glass or loose debris.

Carpet should be rolled and tied with string or rope. Please make sure the rolled carpet has no nails, staples or other sharp objects sticking out. Floor tiles must be bundled and tied. Floor tiles can also placed inside a container or a box.

MATERIAL NOT ACCEPTED FOR HEAVY GARBAGE COLLECTION - Electronics including countertop microwave ovens, video gaming systems & peripheral, GPS Systems, E-book readers, desk top computers, portable computers, computer monitors, computer peripheral, desk top printers, televisions, personal/portable audio & video play back and recording systems, vehicle audio/video systems, home theatre in-a-box (HTB) systems, home audio/video systems, external storage drives & modems, non-cellular telephones and cellular devices.

ALL HAZARDOUS WASTE. (unused paint & empty paint cans, used oil & empty oil containers, glycol & empty glycol containers, other petroleum products & gasoline).

Propane tanks and propane cylinders Small 1 pound cylinders can be dropped off free-of-charge at CBRM's Residential Hazardous Waste Depot.

Fluorescent lights & other mercury containing products, Asphalt roofing shingles, Vehicle parts, Vehicle tires, arial

All hazardous waste. (unused paint & empty paint cans, used oil & empty oil containers, glycol & empty glycol containers, other petroleum products & gasoline).

Large trees, stumps, branches & Leaf and yard debris. Please contact the hotline (902) 567-1337 for proper disposal options for materials listed above.

Unacceptable items will not be removed from the curb. Residents will be required to remove uncollected materials and dispose of it properly.

TAX CHANGES FOR 2024

INCREASE IN UNPAID TAX PENALTY - There are a few rules to pay attention to regarding penalties on unpaid taxes as well as late filings. For 2024, if you have a balance owing, the Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) will charge you compound daily interest on any unpaid amounts starting the day after the balance is due. This holds true for reassessments as well. If you file late for 2024, the penalty is 5% of your 2024 balance owing, plus an additional 1% for each full month that you file after the tax filing due date—to a maximum of 12 months. Looking further back, if the CRA charged you a late-filing penalty for 2021, 2022, or 2023 and requested a formal demand for a return that they haven't received, your late-filing penalty for 2024 will be 10% of your balance owing. Then you will be charged an additional 2% for each full month that you file after the due date—to a maximum of 20 months.

THE BASIC PERSONAL AMOUNT (BPA) INCREASE - As part of their policy to continue increasing it over time, the government boosted the basic personal amount for the 2024 tax year to \$15,705. This increase reduces the amount of income subject to federal tax, providing additional relief to taxpayers.

NEW OAS LIMIT AMOUNTS - The Old Age Security (OAS) benefit is designed to provide retirees with a source of income to support their retirement. However, if your income is more than a certain limit, you might find your OAS amount reduced or even cancelled entirely.

CANADA PENSION PLAN MAXIMUM CONTRIBUTIONS HAVE BEEN INCREASED - The Canada Pension Plan (CPP) and Québec Pension Plan (QPP) have been increased by 6.4%. New for 2024, the first earnings ceiling of the CPP has increased to \$68,500, which will see the 5.95% CPP rate applied. A second ceiling became effective January 1, 2024, up to \$73,200. Individuals earning above the first and below the second ceiling will be subject to an additional CPP contribution.

DISABILITY TAX CREDIT UPDATES - Applying for the Disability Tax Credit (DTC) notoriously has been a lengthy process. However, the CRA made this process easier in 2023 by going digital. Via CRA My Account, individuals wanting to apply can complete Part A of the application, and receive a reference number, which can be provided to a qualified medical practitioner who can then complete Part B digitally for you. There's no need to print and bring the forms to your medical practitioner anymore.
