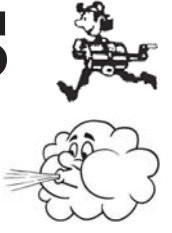

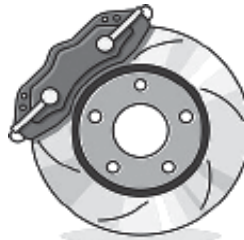

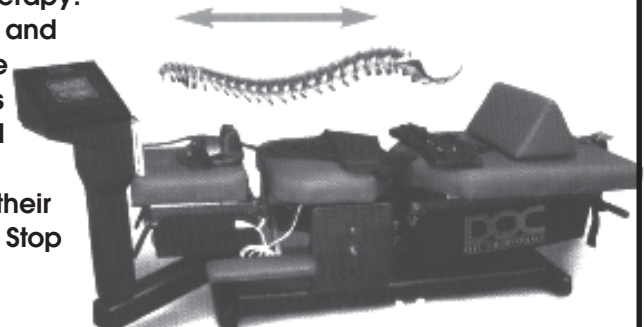

This week I'm writing about 2 movies that are Science Fiction gems-and both have connections to historical figures. The 1979 film 'Time After Time' stars the legendary Malcolm McDowell (Grandpa from 'Son of a Critch') as H.G. Wells; Wells unveils his time machine-that is subsequently stolen by Jack the Ripper (British actor David Warner) who travels to 1979 San Francisco. The amazing line Jack utters is "ninety years ago I was a freak. Today I am an amateur". McDowell's co-star and love interest is played by the young and beautiful Mary Steenburgen. So not only does Wells have to stop Jack, and get his time machine back, he also has to convince the police that he's not insane. That effort isn't helped when he lies to the police about who he is so as to not draw further attention to himself.

The name he gives them? Sherlock Holmes. The second movie is 1990's 'Frankenstein Unbound' and in this case John Hurt portrays a future scientist (Dr. Buchanan) who creates an energy beam weapon that he hopes will actually end wars, but it has an unexpected side-effect; the device creates a ripple effect warping time and space. Buchanan ends up in 1817 Switzerland, eventually meeting Mary Shelley, Lord Byron, Percy Shelley and a doctor named Victor Frankenstein. A series of bad events happen and Frankenstein's monster, Buchanan, a partner for the monster and Dr. Frankenstein get hurled far into the future-to a snow covered barren landscape where even more intense events take place. Bridget Fonda, Raul Julia, Jason Patric and Michael Hutchence (the lead singer of the band INXS) round out the cast. Sci Fi movies are my favourite genre, so to find 2 with historical links was an added bonus.

ABBOT & COSTELLO

Abbott and Costello were an American comedy duo composed of comedians Bud Abbott and Lou Costello, whose work in radio, film, and television made them the most popular comedy team of the 1940s and 1950s, and the highest-paid entertainers in the world during the Second World War.



Their patter routine "Who's on First?" is considered one of the greatest comedy routines of all time, a version of which appears in their 1945 film The Naughty Nineties.

Abbott and Costello made their film debut in the 1940 comedy One Night in the Tropics.

This show was broadcast on November 29, 1945 and is entitled, "Opening A Gas Station."

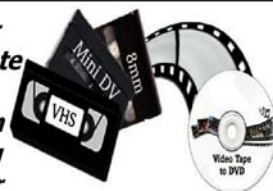

POPULAR TAX DEDUCTIONS

Below are some tax deductions that H&R Block's Tax Experts can help you maximize your return this year:

GST/HST CREDIT - The GST/HST Credit is a refundable tax credit intended to help low- to modest-income Canadians offset the tax they pay on consumer goods and services. .

CHARITABLE DONATION TAX CREDIT - When you donate to a charity, you can receive tax benefits for your donations. The Charitable Donation Tax Credit is a non-refundable tax credit available to anyone who makes a donation to a qualifying donee (i.e., a registered charity).

SELF-EMPLOYMENT EXPENSES - Whether you are self-employed or have a full-time job and earn self-employed income on the side, the CRA allows you to deduct a range of business expenses on your tax return. The most common expenses for self-employed taxpayers include: advertising, vehicle expenses, bank fees, office supplies, inventory, business-use-of-home expenses, mobile phone.

OTHER EMPLOYMENT EXPENSES - Although many employees cannot deduct employment expenses, if your employer requires you to incur certain expenses without reimbursement, you can deduct them on line 22900 (including any GST/HST) as long as they are required according to your employment contract.

CANADA WORKERS BENEFIT (CWB) - The Canada Workers Benefit (CWB) is a refundable tax credit available for low-income individuals in the workforce. You may also qualify for additional payments like the disability supplement. To be eligible, you have to earn more than \$3,000. However, the maximum income level is different in each province.

REGISTERED RETIREMENT SAVINGS PLAN (RRSP) DEDUCTION - Deducting your Registered Retirement Savings Plan (RRSP) contributions reduces your taxable income, which means you're taxed on a smaller amount of money and defer tax on that income until future years when you withdraw the RRSP.

HOME BUYERS' AMOUNT (HBA) - The Home Buyer's Amount (HBA) is a non-refundable tax credit. If you or your spouse or common-law partner purchased a qualifying home in Canada in 2024, you can claim up to \$10,000 which would provide a tax credit of up to \$1,500 (15%), reducing the amount of federal tax you have to pay.

MOVING EXPENSES - Did you know that if you relocated more than 40 km for work, you may be eligible to claim your moving expenses? You can claim eligible moving expenses if you either: moved and established a new home to work or run a business at a new location, moved to be a student in full-time attendance in a post-secondary institution.

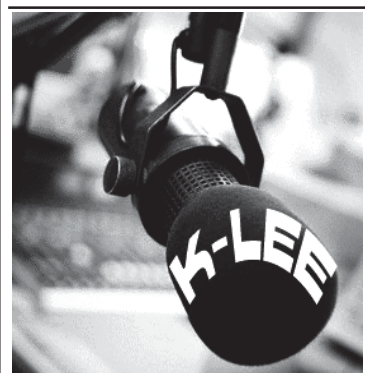
