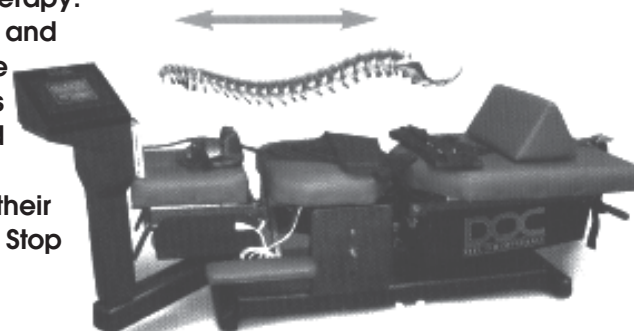

Let's hope that when the repaving is completed, it will not be prone to rutting again. I think that the problem was with the original paving and inferior asphalt that was laid down.

Thank you Fred for recognizing the hazard and doing something about it. I look forward to the new highway and will try not to complain when traffic is being held up during the construction.

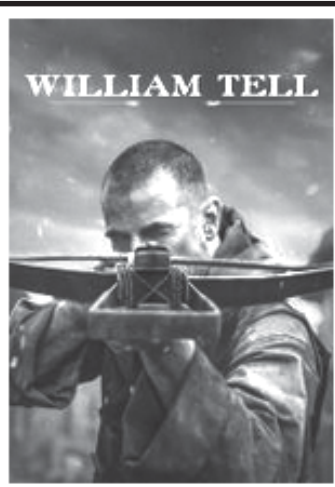

So, what can I tell you about 'William Tell'? it's a new movie set in 1307 Switzerland and chronicles how the Swedes are governed by the tyrannical Austrians. Is the story accurate? Hard to say when there is no evidence that William Tell was ever a real person. His adventures are from a play written in 1804, but to be honest I was more interested in watching something based in that time period-and overall the film, at first, was not bad. Tell is played by Claes Bang, and the only other familiar faces here are Raef Spall and Sir Ben Kingsley in what is one of his more lame acting gigs as King Albert. His golden eye patch alone is cringe-worthy and to be honest there are a few WTF moments that will just have you shaking your head. The sets, locations, battle scenes and armoury are admittedly good-and the actors are skilled. Plus, no one can pick the film apart for historical inaccuracies (as the online nerd

patrol is so used to doing) because it's all fiction. The biggest issue here is that there was so much promise and potential to make this a really good film-alas, to no avail. Critic Helen O'Hara of Empire Magazine stated that "while this old-fashioned tale of folk heroism and hardy underdogs benefits from solid performances and spectacular vistas, ... it loses points for a sequel-baiting ending." Yep, spoiler alert-the ending will not satisfy many-and based on that everything I wrote above that was remotely good gets negated by the ending. Am I sorry that I invested 2 hours watching this film? Yes. Am I happy I didn't flake out dollars to see it in the theatre? Yes.

## POPULAR TAX DEDUCTIONS

*Below are some tax deductions that H&R Block's Tax Experts can help you maximize your return this year:*

**MAKE RESP CONTRIBUTIONS** - RESPs allow for tax efficient savings for children's post secondary education. The federal government will pay into an RESP a Canada Education Savings Grant (CESG) equal to 20% of the first \$2,500 of annual RESP contributions per child or \$500 annually. While unused CESG room is carried forward to the year the beneficiary turns 17, there are a couple of situations in which it may be beneficial to make an RESP contribution by December 31.

Each beneficiary who has unused CESG carry forward room can have up to \$1,000 of CESGs paid into an RESP annually, with a \$7,200 lifetime limit, up to and including the year in which the beneficiary turns 17. If enhanced catch up contributions of \$5,000 (\$2,500 X 2) are made for just over seven years, the maximum total CESGs of \$7,200 will be obtained. If you have less than seven years before your (grand)child turns 17 and haven't maximized RESP contributions, consider making a contribution by December 31.

Also, if your (grand)child turned 15 this year and has never been a beneficiary of an RESP, no CESG can be obtained in future years unless at least \$2,000 is contributed to an RESP by the end of the year. Consider making your contribution by December 31 to receive the current year's CESG and create CESG eligibility for 2025 and 2026.

**TAKE RESP WITHDRAWALS FOR STUDENTS** - If your (grand)child is an RESP beneficiary and attended a post-secondary educational institution in 2024, consider having Educational Assistance Payments (EAPs) made from the RESPs before the end of the year.

Although the amount of the EAP will be included in the income of the student, if the student has sufficient personal tax credits, the EAP income will be effectively tax free. The maximum EAP that can be taken in the first 13 weeks of post-secondary education is \$8,000 for full-time students and \$4,000 for part-time students

**2024 YEAR END TAX TIPS** - If your (grand)child is an RESP beneficiary and stopped attending a post-secondary educational institution in 2024, EAPs can only be paid out for up to six months after the student has left the school. You may, therefore, wish to consider having final EAPs made from RESPs of which the student is a beneficiary.
