## GROCERY REBATE AND TOP UP

Canadians who receive the GST benefit will get a one-time top up payment this spring after parliamentarians fast-tracked the legislation to set it motion.

The Canada Groceries and Essentials Benefit received royal assent last week after passing the final vote in the Senate earlier in the day and the House of Commons last week. call to action.

The finance department says the benefit will provide a one-time top-up payment "as early as possible this spring" worth 50 per cent of the credit.

The normal value of the benefit, which is paid to Canadians with low and modest incomes, will also increase by 25 per cent for five years starting in July.

The government says it will help more than 12 million Canadians and that when combined, the measures mean a family of four will receive up to \$1,890 this year, and about \$1,400 annually for the next four years.

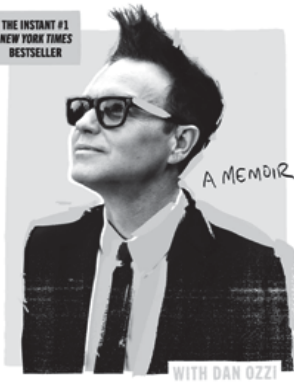

I've mentioned before that I love reading non-fiction books about musicians and bands-especially the ones written by them. The latest is again courtesy of the Regional Library (please support them in any way you can) and its from Blink 182's Mark Hoppus, titled "Farenheit 182". In it Mark laid out his early days growing up in the desert in Ridgecrest, California-a place he said was filled with "geniuses, scientists, physicists, and then just complete strung-out meth-heads". His father Tex, like many in Ridgecrest, worked for the U.S. Department of Defense, designing missiles and bombs for the town's Navy testing center. His parent's eventual broke up and divorced when he was 8 years old and then he moved from place to place, feeling lonely and upset. It was the world of skateboarding and punk rock that basically saved him-going from that to being a Goth and eventually the bass player and singer for one of the most successful

and influential pop punk bands in history. The A to Z's of being in that world are all laid out here-sometimes hilarious, sometimes touching and sometimes just plain insane. Mark spent decades with Blink, had a major falling out with bandmember Tom DeLonge and the band broke up in 2005 so Mark did side projects but Blink eventually reunited and they're still out there. Mark spends the latter part of the book detailing his at times horrific battle with stage 4 lymphoma but on September 29/2021 he announced that he was free and clear. This book is filled with funny, surprising and at times amazingly crazy incidents; what life on the road is like for mega-stars in the music business. This is a great read.

## - TAX TIPS 2026 -

**Childcare Services you can claim** - Childcare services provided by caregivers (including babysitters and nannies); Nursery schools and daycare centres;

Childcare services provided by educational institutions (only the part of your fees related to childcare can be claimed); Day camps and day sports schools where the primary goal of the camp is to care for children (an institution offering a sports study program is not a sports school); or Boarding schools (excluding the amount relating to education), overnight sports schools, or camps where accommodation is involved.

**GET YOUR SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS TOGETHER** - The first step in making a proper claim is getting a receipt for your childcare expenses from your childcare provider. Every receipt needs to be made out to the person who paid for the childcare expenses. If the childcare services were provided by an individual, the receipt should also show the provider's SIN (Social Insurance Number). You don't have to submit your receipts if you're filing electronically, but you do need to keep them in case the CRA or Revenu Québec asks to see them.

**WHO MAKES THE CLAIM?** - The spouse who earns less income will need to claim the childcare expenses on their federal return.

**ALL IN THE FAMILY** - If you pay your parent (say your mother or father-in-law) to look after your children, you can claim the amount you pay them. Keep in mind they'll have to provide you with a receipt that includes their SIN, and report the money you've paid them as income on their return. However, if your child was looked after by their own parent (for example, their own dad) or their parent's spouse (for example, their stepdad), you won't be able to claim the amount you pay them.

**SOME MINORS DON'T COUNT** - Your childcare provider can't be younger than 18 and related to you by blood, marriage or common-law partnership, or adoption. For example, your brother, sister, brother-in-law, sister-in-law are related to you; your niece, nephew, uncle, and aunt aren't. If you pay your 12-year-old to look after their brothers or sisters, this doesn't count as an eligible childcare expense.

Sometimes kids like to emulate their fathers. This next story clearly shows how. There was an early radio and TV show hosted by Art Linkletter where he interviewed young kids and often had them say funny things or reveal family secrets.

That's similar to what happened in this next story from my troubled past. My father had the habit, when he didn't know a particular person, he would call him "Arsehole McGinty". For example, if a new individual moved into our neighbourhood and did something not approved of by the established crew, my father would say something like, "Arsehole McGinty didn't cut his lawn". As a young boy of seven, I naturally thought that Mr. McGinty was a real person. The pastor of our church came for a Sunday visit and asked my father if he knew the name of the new neighbour who just moved in. My father told the pastor, "No, I haven't been introduced to him yet." Hearing this, I immediately piped in, "No daddy, his name is Arsehole McGinty." Needless to say I was banished to my bedroom and my parents had to come up with a good excuse as to my language.
