PETER CRISS - "Makeup to Breakup - This week I'm doing something different from the norm- instead of writing notes about music I'm writing notes, about notes about music. Now that I've got you totally confused I'll explain; it's all about a book- Peter Criss's autobiography to be precise. Of course Peter Criss

was the iconic drummer and a founding member of the rock band Kiss. As the book details, George Peter John Criscuola (real name) was born in 1945 and grew up on the mean streets of Brooklyn, for a time getting in with the 'wrong crowd'-but it was a homemade set of drums that had sparked his passion, and obsession. He spent the better part of the 1960's playing in jazz and rock bands, eventually landing a 2-album deal with the band Chelsea (who then became Lips) but things fizzled out after their first album. It was in 1973 that Peter joined the band that would go on to become legendary in the annals of rock and roll.

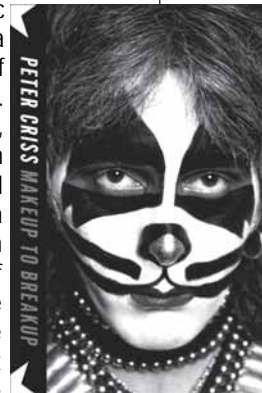
In his own words Peter tells us how the band went literally from rags to riches beyond belief, and how Gene Simmons and Paul Stanley quickly took control over everything- basically relegating Ace Frehley and Peter to being bit players in a band that they helped to create-hired guns, per se. As a matter of fact, the book paints Gene as a megalomaniac,

hell-bent on total control and domination. Throughout their incredibly successful years Peter tried to keep the music the most important thing about the band but Gene once said; "KISS is not a band- it is a brand". That would explain the ridiculous marketing of everything from KISS condoms to KISS coffins- all under Gene's scheming hands.

Peter was no angel throughout his career as a rock star- sex, drugs and rock and roll, and more sex, drugs and rock and roll took their toll on both him and the band. Shortly before Peter was kicked out of KISS he was in a major car accident, which almost cost him his life. That

seemed to just speed up the inevitable- his removal from the band, one which he grew to hate being in because of Gene and Paul. Peter always liked Ace like a brother- even though by that time Ace was a drugged out living embodiment of his 'Space Ace' character. Subsequent reunions only proved Peter's feelings that KISS had been totally co-opted by Gene, Paul and their inside management team- to the detriment of their reputation as a 'real' rock and roll band- and not just comic book characters come to life.

Even though all the members of KISS have books out I bought this one because Peter Criss was, and still is my favourite bandmember- this book reminded me again of why that is. It's a great rock and roll read.

Cape Breton Smile Concert - June 21st

Once again the musicians of Sydney Mines are teaming up and presenting the third in their series of seasonal concerts at St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church on June 21st— the summer solstice.
