After consideration, Bob Quinn and the partnering staff at St. Andrews agree that scope of this production forces too many challenges on the church, which was set to host the premiere of the new show.

Fear not, ticket holders - the producers are offering those who have purchased tickets a "rain date" at the large Macaulay Centre in Baddeck the home of the musical- Cape Breton Smile. KISS - "KISS 40" Universal

- Two weeks ago my review featured Peter Criss's autobiography, detailing his time in and out of the band KISS. So I thought the timing was perfect to write about this new release; "Kiss 40-Decades of Decibels" obviously marks the band's 40 years as a rock and roll entity.

Interestingly enough, Peter Criss did join Gene, Paul and Ace onstage in April to accept their Rock and Roll Hall of Fame Induction awards-but there was no live performance. The bad blood still flows, and KISS are scheduled to play in Toronto in August but it will be without Peter and Ace. That's too bad because this 2 album set only serves to remind us once again just how much better KISS's early songs really were, with Peter and Ace's input. This set includes one track from every album KISS ever released, amounting to a super greatest hits collection plus some extra musical treats; there are some 'first-time' commercially available songs here-live versions of "Deuce", "Cold Gin" and "Crazy Crazy Nights", which will all wet the appetites of KISS Army members and fans alike, as well as a 1977 demo



version of "Reputation" and "God of Thunder". It's also good to see songs from each of the band member's solo albums included, as well as a song from the relatively obscure "Songs from the Elder" concept album. Of course all the big hits are here as well (too many to actually

Powerlifter Competes In South Africa

For Matthew Jessome, it was a dream come true. He was representing Canada in a World Powerlifting competition that brought him from his Cape Breton home to South Africa, where he competed against athletes from all over the world.

Matthew became interested in powerlifting at age 13 and he decided that he wanted to pursue this sport and by the time he was 16, he was competing at the Canadian Powerlifting competition in Ontario where he came away with first place in his weight division.

Matthew is a dedicated athlete and he has trained extensively all on his own without the benefit of a coach.

His dedication was rewarded at the April competition in Ontario and the members of the Canadian Powerlifting team recognized his potential and he became a member of the Canadian contingent that would represent Canada in the South Africa competition.

Matthew discussed his trip to South Africa and remembers that it was a long and taxing trip. The host country officials were extremely friendly and helpful to the powerlifter but he had some vivid memories of the training.

We would assume that Africa was very hot but Matthew remembers that in the early morning when they were training and tuning up, it was quite cold and the training facilities were outdoors and the tempera-

ture required layers of clothing.

There were 35 countries represented at the competition and 16 Canadian lifters and two coaches made up the Canadian team.

Matthew said he gained valuable experience from the coaching staff as well as many of the other lifters who passed along training and competing tips to him.

The biggest key for Matthew is keeping the weight level so he can compete in his given classification. He plans to compete in the 74 kilo class at the Eastern Canadian competitions in November and the Nationals in March of 2015.

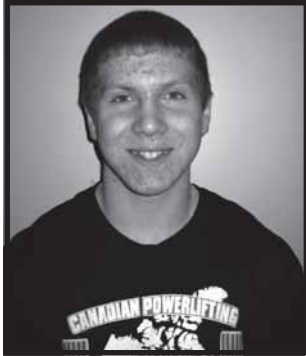
Training is the key to maintaining his peak performance and it is often an individual task and Matthew has that

dedication and desire. Matthew wanted to say a special Thank You to all the local people who have encouraged and supported his career and their assistance in helping him with his trip to South Africa.

There is no doubt that you will be hearing more of this gifted athlete in future competitions. He finished 5th in his class at the World Competition and he is determined to rank higher in upcoming competitions.
