Goodbye To Old Friend Maritime Merchant

Technology has caught up with weekly publication Maritime Merchant.

After 26 years, publisher Larry Buck has put the final edition "to bed." He cites internet sites such as Craig's List, Kijiji and Facebook eroding the volume of classified ads.

The Merchant employed as many as 13 employees in its heyday. The office building on Townsend Street has been sold.

It appears the the Chronicle Herald will publish a broadsheet in Cape Breton and distribute it for free. Time will tell if the Chronicle Herald can be competitive in this market.

I have a personal relationship with the Maritime Merchant, which began its run as "Maritime Trader" and changed its name after The Auto Trader objected to the word "Trader" in the masthead.

The first 6 editions of the paper were set on my 9 inch black and white Apple Macintosh until we moved to an office on Prince Street in Sydney and laid out the paper at The Mic Mac News in Membertou.

I have many fond memories of working with the people at the Merchant and wish Larry Buck the best in his retirement.

"It's All About The Music"

LOREENA McKENNITT - "The Journey So Far" Universal - Well, St. Paddy's Day is gone again for another year but it's always a good time to take a look at new Celtic music releases; this time it's Canadian artist Loreena McKennitt. She was born in Manitoba and is of Irish/Scottish descent so her pedigree lends itself well to Celtic music. Loreena first came to the attention of the masses in 1985 with her debut album, showcasing her amazing voice and nimble finger-picking on the harp, piano and accordion. Her ability to combine Celtic traditions with New Age and World Music elements soon set her at the forefront of the modern Celtic and Folk music movement. The album consists of 12 songs picked by Loreena, based on fan favourites over the years. The hauntingly beautiful sound of the Uilleann pipes ushers in the song "Bonny Portmore", a lament for the loss of Ireland's old oak forests in the 1700's, for shipbuilding. The

song is intense and touching. The William Butler Yeats inspired "Down By The Sally Gardens" draws upon the words of an old peasant woman from Ballisodaire, in Sligo, Ireland. I have to say that I enjoyed my time in Sligo, which



makes this number so much more likeable for me-and it showcases Loreena's incredibly powerful voice. The Uilleann pipes are here as well, and it's easy to understand why they have been called "The True Voice of Ireland", with their soulful cry. That true voice of Ireland touches the listener's ears again on the number "The Old Ways". "The Bonny Swans" harkens back to the English 1656 murder ballad

"The Twa Sisters", which tells the tale of a sister who drowned her own sister, and how the victim's bones and hairs wash up onshore and were fashioned into a harp which plays itself, singing out the details of the murder and its motives-jealousy and unrequited love.

Loreena's first album is represented with "The Stolen Child", another Yeats poem; this one chronicles the tale of faeries trying to lure a child away with them. The song was also released a few years later by The Waterboys. Celtic mysticism has always been a huge part of Loreena's modus operandi with this song being a great example of that. Ancient lore rears its head again on the number "The Lady of Shallott", as Loreena waxes daintily on the Arthurian legend of Elaine of Astolat, testament to how flawless Loreena can take legends and folktales and spin them into musical magic. This album is filled with musical magic-songs that are stirring, haunting, imaginative and most of all-thoroughly entertaining.

2014 TAX TIPS FROM H & R BLOCK

As a self-employed individual, you and your spouse or common-law partner have until **midnight on Monday, June 16, 2014**, because June 15, 2014 falls on a Sunday, to file your 2013 income tax and benefit return. But don't forget—you must pay any balance owing for 2013 on or before April 30, 2014, regardless of your filing date.

Important facts

If you earned self-employment income from a business you operate yourself or with a partner, you have to report it. For more information, go to www.cra.gc.ca/selfemployed.

Keep thorough records if you own a business or are engaged in a commercial activity. The records have to give enough detail to determine the taxes you owe and support the benefits you are claiming, and they must be supported by original documents.

If you receive income that has no tax withheld or does not have enough tax withheld for more than one year, you may have to pay tax by instalments. This can happen if you receive rental, investment, or self-employment income, certain pension payments, or income from more than one job. For more information, go to www.cra.gc.ca/instalments.

If you bought a home in 2013, the Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) has a tax credit and a plan that may help you save on this purchase. First-time home buyers' tax credit - If you are a first-time home buyer, you may be able to claim a non-refundable tax credit of up to \$750 on the purchase of a qualifying home.

To qualify for the home buyer's tax amount: - you or your spouse or common-law partner must have bought a qualifying home; **and** - you can't have lived in another home owned by you or your spouse or common-law partner that year or in any of the four preceding years.

If you are buying a home and are eligible for the disability tax credit or if you are an individual buying a home for a related person who is eligible for the disability tax credit, you may also qualify for this credit even if you have already owned a home. A qualifying home must be registered in your name, in your spouse's or common-law partner's name, or in both names, according to the applicable land registration system, and must be located in Canada. It includes existing homes such as single-family houses, semi-detached houses, townhouses, mobile homes, condominium units, apartments in duplexes, triplexes, fourplexes, or apartment buildings, and homes under construction.

Proposed Monument to Canada's War Dead

The more I think about it, the more I am convinced of the merits of locating the proposed monument to Canada's war dead at the former Princess No. 1 Colliery mine site at the Cranberry Head / Swivel Point area in Sydney Mines. And how exiting it would have been, at the time, to be able to witness a naval battle that *"took place off Sydney Mines between French and British warships on July 21, 1781 resulting in a tactical French victory, although strategically inconsequential"*. Simply by entering the words "Sydney Mines" into the Google search engine it led me to the Wikipedia web site where the complete story about this battle is illustrated along with what appears to be a photo of a painting of the battle as it was in progress.

I am learning more every day, through my various research efforts, and I am becoming more and more fascinated with the historical significance of this particular area of Sydney Mines. This may seem a little extreme and some may say it is only a pipe dream but, to my way of thinking, there should be very serious consideration, by the powers that be, of having the Cranberry Head / Swivel Point area, Lochman's beach, and the Chapel Point Fortifications site taken over by Parks Canada for the purpose of developing a world class Tourism Destination with the centre piece being the erection of a monument to Canada's war dead at the former Princess No.1 Colliery Mine site, thus leaving the currently proposed Green Cove location undisturbed, as it should be.

What a great way to educate the world about the very important things that have happened here throughout our history. It might also be a good idea for anyone who has similar views on the proposed project to also speak up by submitting their own thoughts in the form of a Letter to the Editor and / or by submitting their own article in the Northside This Week .

How else are we going to be able to encourage badly needed economic development for our area to occur if we don't at least make some efforts to raise awareness of the potential that exists, right under our noses, in our own backyard.
