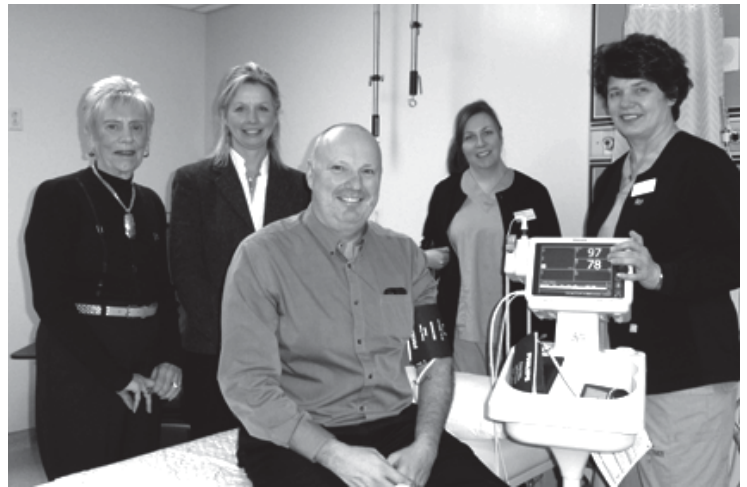

2014 TAX TIPS FROM H & R BLOCK

QUESTION - Is a laptop being used for school tax deductible? Are textbooks?

ANSWER - The good news is the Federal Government introduced the Textbook Tax Credit for post-secondary students in May 2006. This means a full-time student can claim \$65 per month for textbooks or \$20 per month for part-time students. The bad news is the laptop is not deductible.

QUESTION - My mother lives with us, she is 84 this year and earns only pension income. Are there any deductions we can claim? She has been ill over the last 12 years and we do take care of her although she makes a small contribution monthly towards household expenses.

ANSWER - Depending on her income you should be able to claim the caregiver credit and the family caregiver credit for her. Have you applied for the Disability Tax Credit as well? If not get a form T2201 and have her Dr fill it out. That could transfer to you as well and give you a large credit.

QUESTION - I am living common-law for over a year and will file my taxes as such. Is it better to file separately from my spouse? I have tuition amounts carried over but that is about it.

ANSWER - If you live common-law you are required to file as such.
