The pictures would be photocopied and returned. The intent is to use the images for a rug hooking project.

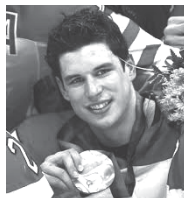

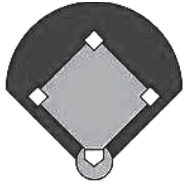

"It's All About The Music"

CELTIC WOMAN - "Emerald Music Gems" Universal

With Saint Patrick's Day just 11 days away it's only fitting to take a listen to a new Celtic music release. The truth is that Celtic Woman is indeed a production, a musical ensemble created by the Riverdance people, and to some it is basically Celtic Thunder in dresses, or Celtic-lite, but there's no denying the high quality of the songs. As with Celtic Thunder there have been line up changes since Celtic Woman's formation in 2004 but this latest incarnation features a full-on Irish line up with Chloe Agnew, Susan McFadden, Lisa Lambe and the angelic Mairead Nesbitt on fiddle; both she and Chloe have been a part of this group since day 1. That consistency shows because no matter what detractors might think or say, this album is really good.

It starts off with the Gaelic (Irish) song "Mo Ghile Mear", which is an 18th century lament

from the goddess Eire for exiled Bonnie Prince Charlie. Remember this; it was the Irish who brought Gaelic to Scotland and to the world. That native tongue sings true on this album with the Irish seaweed song "Dulaman" and the rollicking "Nil Sen La" sung in both Irish and English.



Of course more familiar traditional fare is also on tap with a stirring version of "She Moved Through The Fair", "Amazing Grace" (complete with a bagpipe intro), and "The Parting Glass", which was written in 1770 and was the most popular parting song in Scotland until Robbie Burns penned "Auld

Lang Syne". There's also a moving rendition of "Danny Boy" which is also known as the "Londonderry Air", but for me the best song on the whole album is Dougie MacLean's 1977 penned "Caledonia"-the Roman name for Scotland. It's a song about leaving home but never having home leave your heart-and wanting to return, something so many of us can relate to-probably with a tear or two.

In 1996 the song "The Voice", sung by Eimear Quinn, won the Eurovision Song Contest. It's a stirring ode to a Mother Nature-like figure who watches over the world, and it is performed to perfection here. The hauntingly beautiful drone of the Uilleann pipes roll through the instrumental "The New Ground" and the contemporary music world is well-represented with covers of Simon & Garfunkel's "Bridge Over Troubled Waters" and Josh Groban's "You Raise Me Up"-the ladies delivery on them is impressive, as is this whole album. So press play, raise a glass and enjoy.

2014 TAX TIPS FROM H & R BLOCK**Line 215 or Line 330 Attendant Care Expenses**

Attendant care expenses can only be claimed for amounts paid to an attendant who was not the taxpayer's spouse or common-law partner, and who was at least 18 years old when the payments were made. Attendant care costs can be claimed for persons who are eligible for the disability amount (see the article on disability amount tax credit), and in some situations for persons who do not qualify for the disability amount.

- You can claim attendant care costs for amounts paid, by you or your spouse or common-law partner, for the care of yourself
- your spouse or common-law partner
- your or your spouse or common-law partner's dependent child under age 18
- other eligible dependents of you or your spouse or common-law partner: a dependent child aged 18 or over
- a dependent grandchild
- a dependent parent, grandparent, brother, sister, aunt, uncle, niece or nephew, if they lived in Canada at any time during the year.

Attendant care costs for other eligible dependents are claimed as medical expenses, and are subject to the federal and provincial/territorial limits for medical expenses for other eligible dependents.

If attendant care expenses are paid to an individual, your receipt must include their social insurance number. The individual will either be a self-employed contractor, or your employee. If the individual is an employee, you will be required to deduct from their pay and remit income tax, CPP contributions, and EI premiums. You will also have to pay the employer portion of CPP contributions and EI premiums, which would be part of your total attendant care costs. The amounts that you pay to an employee are subject to the rules for minimum wages rates and other employment standards for your province or territory. To determine whether the person is an employee or a contractor, see our article on employee vs self-employed contractor.

Attendant care expenses for persons who do not qualify for the disability amount. When a person does not qualify for the disability amount, in order for attendant care costs to be claimed, a medical practitioner must certify in writing that the person needs a full-time attendant due to mental or physical infirmity and will likely continue to be dependent on others for the long term.
