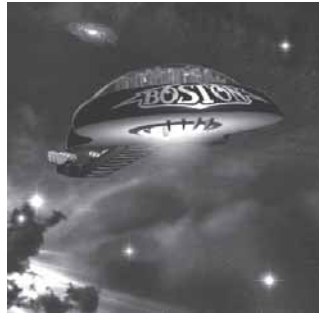

BOSTON - "Life, Love and Hope" Frontiers Records - It's an interesting fact that before this album came out (December 3/2013) Boston had only released 5 albums since 1976. That speaks volumes about their distinctive sound, the quality of their songs and the lasting impression they have made in the world of rock and roll.

The song "Heaven On Earth" kicks this album off in fine style, with that unique Boston sound we've come accustomed to. By the way, all the instruments and vocals on the track were done by Tom Scholz. The song "Last Day Of School" really reminds me of the band Styx's work-it's a great number, and the album's namesake-"Life, Love And Hope" is a straight-ahead 80's retro-rock song, featuring Tommy DeCarlo's

instantly recognizable voice.

The band suffered a huge blow with the passing of lead singer Brad Delph in March of 2007, but 3 of the tracks on this al-



bum were recorded before Brad's passing, and feature him on vocals; "Didn't Mean To Fall In Love" is an amazing song, with a super-cool intro that leads into the great fretwork by lead guitarist Tom Scholz. Tom is on record as saying; "I intentionally stayed close to the early BOSTON style on some of the songs, even using the same amps

and instruments; on others I let my imagination run wild", and that intention worked perfectly here.

The other songs featuring Brad Delph, "Sail Away" and "Someone 2.0" are quintessential Boston numbers that give a huge nod back to the band's 1978 "Don't Look Back" album; "Sail Away" is a meaningful, touchingly perfect swan song that also features the band's bass player Kimberley Dahme on vocals and "Someone 2.0" is a textbook perfect FM rock song-a multi-layered musical masterpiece. The band takes a bit of a departure on "Someday", which still has that unique Boston sound, but it also has a 'newer' feel to it. It's a cool song.

In closing, let's hope that it's not another 11 years before Boston releases an album; but then again, this collection made that wait well worth it.
