ROB ZOMBIE - I have to start off by stating that this week's review is not for the squeamish, or the easily offended. However, fans of horror and Rob Zombie in particular will find it devilishly delightful. Man I wish this album was released on October 31st. Continue on....if you dare!

with the grinding dirge-like "The Last of the Demons Defeated"; anyone who knows Rob's music will not be surprised by this one, as the song's maniacal chant gets the ball rolling right into "Satanic Cyanide! The Killer Rocks On!"; if Hades had a slip-n-slide ride this would be the soundtrack.

With the tracks "In The Bone Pile" and "Medication for the Melancholy" the listener gets dragged into a truly nightmarish version of a place where Halloween is 24/7-365. To merely describe these songs as horror schlock-rock would be a huge disservice- this is heavy metal at its wickedest, yet always presented in a bit of a tongue-in-cheek manner.

"The Life and Times of a Teenage Rock God" hits like a thousand pound slab of iron dropped on your head (and that's meant as a compliment) and the song "Well Everybody's F*cking in a U.F.O." is funny as hell, with a hillbilly rap and staccato verses, the title serving as the chorus and this song is just plain nuts (another compliment intended).

There are 12 tracks on the album and it closes off with the song "Wurdalak"-which may very well be the heaviest song I've ever heard Rob Zombie do. The word Wurdalak refers to a particular type of Russian vampire that feeds off its family's blood, but in Rob's case he based the song on the trilogy movie that was actually titled "Black Sabbath", starring Boris Karloff. To close, I love this album a lot-but I'll probably keep the lights on when I play it again. Enjoy!

Rob released a number of albums, EP's and remixes with White Zombie before calling it quits in 1998; at that point he was somewhat disillusioned with the inside 'BS' the band was dealing with. Before the end though he started working on some solo stuff, and that was when Rob Zombie became a solo entity-which given the fact that he grew up in a carnival sideshow, loved comic books, Alice Cooper and horror movies it made total sense, and laid the foundation for all things to come.

This album is actually called "The Electric Warlock Acid Witch Satanic Orgy Celebration Dispenser", and no, Rob Zombie is not a Satanist. He is however a purveyor of things shocking and horrific, and don't a lot of us love a good "bool".

Rob Zombie described this album as " a soundtrack for a bad acid trip", filled with over-the-top mayhem and the macabre. The album opens up

Givin' Back to the Mac Benefit Concert

At \$20 a ticket, it's the best deal in town: a benefit concert on Sunday at Sydney's Centre 200 in aid of the people driven from their homes by a wildfire in Fort McMurray.

Tickets went on sale this morning for Givin' Back to the Mac and it wasn't long before the lineup was out the door of the box office.

Cape Breton regional Mayor Cecil Clarke placed a call to musician and studio owner Fred Lavery just a few days after Fort McMurray was evacuated. In a matter of hours, Lavery had pulled together a lineup of some of the island's best-loved performers.

Headliner Matt Minglewood, who has performed in Fort McMurray countless times, says there was no shortage of musicians volunteering to play.

"The outpouring of musicians to get involved in this, we could have had 700 performers," he said. "The phone calls, even just to me, have been off the wall, with people wanting to play, but I guess they [organizers] have to keep it down to at least four hours." Minglewood says everyone just wants to help.

"For many of us Maritimers, especially Cape Bretoners, Fort Mac is our saviour," he said. "I kept saying this for years, 'Thank God for Alberta and Fort Mac and the work out there.' My son's out there working.

"To see the devastation and just the chaos that ensued, the whole country has to get behind it and fix it because it's the lifeblood of Canada."

"It's very important in situations like this to be able to have a laugh, to have some release, because it's so, so stressful, it's horrifying and whatever comfort you can find in situations like that, you have to take it," said MacDonald.
