

2015 TAX TIPS FROM CH ACCOUNTING & TAX

Does your elderly parent or sibling live with you? And do you know that the Caregiver Amount is different and separate from the Family Caregiver Amount?

Caregiver Amount: You may qualify for the Caregiver Amount if, at any time in 2015, you (either alone or with another person) maintained a dwelling where you and one or more of your dependants lived, you may be able to claim a maximum amount of \$4,608 for each dependant.

Each dependant must have met all of the following criteria:

- · He or she was 18 years of age or older
- He or she had a net income in 2015 (line 236 of his or her return, or it would have been if he or she filed a return) of less than \$20.343
- He or she was dependent on you due to an impairment in physical or mental functions or, if he or she is your or your spouse's or common-law partner's parent or grandparent, was born in 1950 or earlier
- He or she is your or your spouse's or common-law partner's child, grandchild, brother, sister, niece, nephew, aunt, uncle, parent, or grandparent who was resident in Canada So if your parent(s) lives with you, was born in 1950 or earlier, and their net income was less than \$20,343 you will qualify! That parent does not have to be physically or mentally impaired to qualify!

Family Caregiver Amount: This credit is different and separate from the Family Caregiver Amount (FCA), which requires the dependant must be physically or mentally impaired, and allows for an additional \$2,093 per dependant.

If you have any questions about your qualifications, speak to your tax professional before making the claim.



"Kurt Cobain-Montage of Heck" DVD, -A lot has been written about, and speculated on the life of Kurt Cobain. As the lead singer and frontman for Nirvana, Curt became the reluctant poster boy for the antiestablishment Grunge movement, and for a whole disenfranchised generation.

From 1987 to 1994 (when Kurt committed suicide) Nirvana

only released 3 studio albums and 1 live album but their legacy continues to this day both musically and visually (re-releases, band logo on posters, t-shirts, etc) and ironically that's where the problem lay for Kurt Cobain. He



This documentary was released last year and not only had the full support of Courtney Love Cobain

(Kurt's widow) she sought out the right people who could bring the project to the big screen. As a matter of fact, Kurt and Courtney's daughter, Frances Bean Cobain, was the co-executive producer of the film, with famed documentary producer Brett Morgen serving as director and producer.

This is not an 'easy watch'. If anything, it clearly illustrates how messed up Kurt and Courtney's life was.

Along with interviews, this documentary includes live

performance clips of Nirvana, some of Kurt's demo recordings, his journal entries and sketches, 8mm home movies of his early childhood and some unfiltered home movies of Kurt and Courtney together, which may be the most revealing of all; at times they destroy his aura as a legend and show Kurt as a deeply flawed, disturbed and troubled human being who was just trying to wrestle with

> his personal demons, and not destroy everything around him in the process. He was constantly struggling to be true to himself and to others-as husband, a father and a human

being, and as an artist. In retrospect, we can look back and see here the times where Kurt Cobain hinted at ending it all.

The main documentary has a running time of 132 minutes, the bonus features include interviews (not used in the film) with Wendy O'Connor (Kurt's mom), Don and Kim Cobain (his dad and sister), Courtney Love Cobain and Brett Morgen.

There's also a really cool photo gallery featuring some of Kurt's guitars, toys, paintings and more. This DVD version also comes with 1 of 4 collectible postcards. After watching this documentary you can see that Kurt Cobain was a beautiful disaster, a perfect storm of conflicted emotions, always crossing the line between genius and insanityand he was also brilliantly fascinating. That is what this documentary is as well.
