## 2015 TAX TIPS FROM CH ACCOUNTING & TAX

### Tax Reviews, Audits and keeping your records...

Each year, the CRA conducts a number of review activities that promote awareness of and compliance with the laws it administers. These reviews are simply a request for you to provide proof of claims you made on your personal taxes; A REVIEW IS NOT A TAX AUDIT.

Each of the review types (Pre-assessment, Processing Reviews and the Matching Program) is conducted at a particular point of the tax assessment - some happen before your refund and Notice of Assessment are issued, while others may happen long after you have filed and received your refund.

A tax review is an easy thing to satisfy if you keep all of your tax information together after filing. We recommend that you keep all tax papers together, and hold on to the last 7 years' returns at minimum. If you are selected for review, bring the letter you received as well as the tax paperwork that you used to file your return right back to your preparer and have them assist you with the Review response. All registered Efilers should have no problem assisting you with a tax review.

If you are selected for review remember that it's not an audit, the CRA simply needs more information to substantiate a claim you made on your return.....gather your papers and call your Professional Tax Preparer!

For those of you who have yet to file your 2015 taxes - you are now late, and there are penalties and interest accumulating daily - call today and we can get you filed asap!

**PRINCE – “HITnRUN Phase Two”** - At times life can be full of cruel ironies, and the music business is not immune to such ironies. On January 8<sup>th</sup> of this year David Bowie released his “Blackstar” album, and passed away 2 days later. This Prince album was meant to be a continuation of Prince’s “HITnRUN Phase one” album, which came out last September. This one was actually released last December, but was only available on the Tidal streaming service, and later at Prince’s live concerts, such as the one on March 25<sup>th</sup> in Toronto. Of course, we all know what happened on April 21<sup>st</sup>., and even though its been reported that there’s loads of unreleased material in the Prince music vault, this the last album to be released while Prince was still alive.



here from an early Sly and the Family Stone record, yet still retains its originality and vitality. Its’ easy to hear elements of the song “1999” on the track “Rocknroll Loveaffair”; this song totally sounds like a lost Huey Lewis and the News number-give it a listen and you’ll hear exactly what I mean. The most contemporary song here is “Screwdriver”, with its hard drumming and low-end bass vibrate the number is a blast of pop/rock and roll energy that totally comes across as something new, fresh and alive-with a little bit of a James Brown twist thrown in for good measure. I could easily see this song making the Top 40 charts.

Continuing on, “Black Muse” has one of the catchiest low-ends I’ve heard in a long time, and even though at first it sounds like a Michael Jackson song, this is classic Prince at his best, and the same thing can be said for the song “Xtraloveable”. These numbers really do shed light on just how much of a musical genius Prince Rogers Nelson really was (not that we needed more proof of that).

With this album Prince created a perfect blend-making old school new again and sounding fresher than ever. Prince was a musical visionary, a guitar virtuoso, a producer of perfection and truly a one-of-a kind Renaissance man. One could never hope for a better swan song.

This album is fantastic, and Prince will be missed.

So how is this album? Absolutely amazing. How’s that for an endorsement? “Look At Me Look At U” is a sultry, sexy and jazzy number that reminds me of a 1976 era Boz Scaggs song, complete with old-school keyboards, funky guitar and slappin’ bass lines; “Groovy Potential” is all about the brassy funk as the number steps along like an updated version of a Brothers Johnson tune from way back in 1980. This is definitely one of the best songs on this album and Prince’s voice is ‘super-cool on overdrive’ here. Keeping that theme going, the song “Big City” sounds like it time-traveled to
