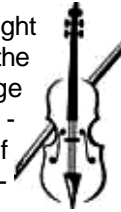

TOTO - "Live at Montreux 1991" **Eagle Vision** - Most people know the band Toto for their 3 biggest hit songs that came out between 1978 and 1982; "Africa," "Rosanna" and "Hold the Line." However, we can't forget their great songs "99", "I Won't Hold You Back" and "Pamela". As a matter of fact, after 1982 Toto released 10 more albums-so they've maintained a steady presence in the music world.

This concert is from their 1991 show in Montreux, Switzerland and features four-sixt the band's original line-up; Steve Lukather, David Paich, Mike Porcara and Jeff Procaro. 1991 was an interesting year for Toto as they had just split from lead vocalist Jean-Michel Byron, with guitarist Steve Lukather taking over vocals. The band was also on tour, trying to make some older songs sound fresher, and giving new tracks a good workout on stage, in front of a live crowd.

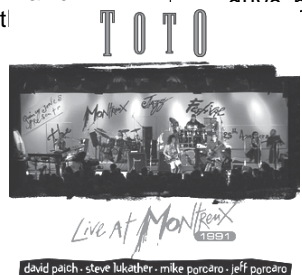
That effort is well reflected here as the band worked some new material into their set, including the tracks "Kingdom of Desire" and "Jake To The Bone"-both songs are fantastic to see and hear in this performance.

The set list also includes "On The Run", "I'll Be Over You", "Red House", "Rosanna", "Africa" and "I Want To Take You Higher". So as you can see, this was not an "oldies but goodies"

show, it was a snapshot of a band that was still vibrant musically, creatively and performance-wise. The concert's running time is just a bit over the hour mark but that brevity is a good thing as the music just picks you up and carries you along, and it's over before you know it. There's also the companion audio CD with the same tracks-a treat for the ears.

The concert DVD looks great and the sound quality is excellent-which should come as no surprise since Lukather, Paich, and the Porcaro brothers had an extensive resume as session musicians going way back-it's been estimated that individually they have played back-up on 5000 albums (Steely Dan, Sonny & Cher, Boz Scaggs and Michael Jackson- to name just a few).

1991 was also a bittersweet year for the band as it turned out to be their last days on stage with drummer Jeff Porcaro, who passed away on August 5th of 1992 from heart disease (although there was sufficient evidence to link his death with insecticides he was using on his yard earlier that day). That tragedy makes this DVD release somewhat bittersweet-when they edited and mastered the concert Steve Lukather was quoted as saying "There were tears and a lot of laughter as the memories of this night and this final tour with Jeff were captured. You guys get to see a version of the band that will never and COULD never be again!" Reason enough to check this concert out. Enjoy!

Storytelling - Robert O'Hearn

PRESENTING THE STORY - The last few issues you've read a few tales and now you're ready to tell your story in front of people! Wow! You are all set, if you've been following some of the last issues pointers. Here's how to do it: Make sure you have everything you need (props, your special storytelling hat or cape, etc.). Try not to sound nervous, even if you are! Make sure everyone is quiet and ready to listen before you begin. Tell them where you got your story. Did you get it from a book? Is it an old fairy tale or an old legend?

Look people in the eye while telling the story., You could also have the audience repeat lines with you, such as, "Not by the hair of my chinny, chin, chin!" Its fun when they participate. If people get loud, pause wait for a second until they stop talking. Do not be mean or they won't like your story. Don't answer questions during the story. Begin and end your story in a good way. Make sure you practice and practice! You will make mistakes, and that's okay! Just pause and then go on. Don't say you're sorry for the mistake because that just draws more attention to it. Making mistakes is a part of making anything, so don't let it bother you. Most importantly: try to have fun! Try telling a Russian Fairy Tale. There is a longer version, but I'll give you a shorter version to try out.

Morozko (Old Man Winter) - One widower had a lovely daughter. He remarried to a woman who had a daughter herself from a previous marriage. The stepmother hated her new stepdaughter and ordered her husband to take the girl to the forest and leave her there.

The old man grieved, but nothing to do, he took his daughter to the winter forest. She was sitting in the snow and was cold to the bone. At that time Morozko went for a walk and saw the shivering girl. He asked her if she was warm. The nice girl did not want to hurt his feelings and politely replied that she was warm. He admired her stoicism and showed his mercy. He gave her warm fur coat and the box with gold and silver jewelry as a present.

Alive and unharmed, the girl returned home. After she told what happened in the woods, the greedy stepmother sent her own daughter to the same spot in the forest because she also wanted to get jewelry. But that girl was rude and Morozko froze her stiff. Later the man's daughter got married, had children and lived happily.

Now you are learning how pieces of a story puzzle are put together. Always dress up your mind with plenty of practice. Success happens with trying and trying again. You will want to make sure your mind isn't too bulky. Keep things simple and easy to follow. Then your listeners will easily stay with the logic of the story. Incidentally, remember the old adage, "be your own man (woman)", Well, just be yourself and have fun.

Storytelling is more than talking and the telling of tales Its about discovery too. We'll talk next time about "self-discovery" in storytelling.
