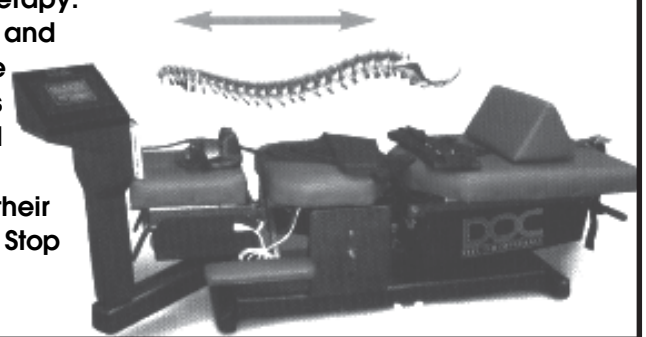

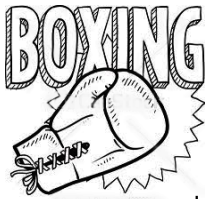

**BLONDIE – "Pollinator"** - It's a very rare occurrence indeed when a band that started in the 1970's releases a new album that's as good as anything they did in their most popular period but that's exactly what Blondie has done with this album. For those of you who don't know much about the band - here's the Cliff Notes; the band hit the mainstream in 1976 with their fantastic debut album that showcased



a cutting-edge pop/punk band led by the sultry and slightly naughty Debbie Harry. They followed that success up with 5 more incredible albums before disbanding in 1982 due to declining record sales, some drug abuse, pressures of the music business and ironically, some genuine animosity from the band towards lead singer Debbie Harry always stealing the limelight, the mass-media attention and fame that was being directed her way. All the original members did reunite in 1997 and released more albums under the Blondie name-making this album number 11 in a long line of great work. The album starts off with the jaw-dropping "Doom or Destiny" -

the song makes you think that Blondie was stuck in a musical time warp, and for all the right reasons. This song is incredible, as good as anything the band ever released in their early days, and interestingly enough it sounds like the theme song for the TV series "Orange is the New Black" - with the icing on the cake being Joan Jett on backing vocals. The song "Long Time" has a real "Heart of Glass" influence running through the beat - his is the Blondie fans remember and love. The funky alt-pop track "Fun" is so fresh and current, and for a change the number "Best Day Ever" (co written by Sia)

reminds me of something Tegan and Sara might do - a real cool alt pop track. Similarly, it's easy to imagine Florence and the Machine doing the edgy and intense song "Gravity", and "Too Much" is another song well-suited for Tegan and Sara to cover, but done to perfection here by Debbie and the boys. The album closes off with "Fragments" and interestingly enough it sounds like a theme song for a James Bond movie; which speaks volumes about the fact that the band actually wrote and recorded "For Your Eyes Only" in 1982 for the James Bond movie of the same name, but the movie producers went with Sheena Easton's version instead. To close, this is the best album Blondie has released in 37 years.
