



STYX - "The Mission"

Although the band Styx has released 16 albums since forming in 1972 they were always at their best when the album had a theme, or a concept, such as the "Kilroy Was Here" and "Paradise Theatre" albums. The last Styx studio album was released in 2005-so their return was

welcomed b many fans.

I mentioned concept albums- and this one is such; it tells the story of a mission to the planet Mars. The storyline was written by Tommy

Shaw and Will Evankovich, and the band announced the album in conjunction with the release of the lead single "Gone Gone Gone", while "Radio Silence" and "Hundred Million Miles from Home" were later made available before the actual album release. "Gone Gone Gone" has Canadian Lawrence Gowan doing another great job here as one of the band's lead singers and keyboard player (a gig he's had since May of 1999) ushering in what is an instant

classic Styx track, complete with all their trademark sounds; Gowan also does lead vocals on "Radio Silence" and does a fantastic job on "The Greater Good".

The song "Hundred Million Miles from Home" features Tommy Shaw on lead vocals (he is actually my favourite singer in the band) and he is incredible on the songs "Locomotive" and "Red Storm". The band stretches its creative touch on a song that will blow your mind

when you hear just how much Styx sounds like The Beatles on "Mission To Mars", and "Trouble At The Big Show" (with James Young on vocals) is a surprise-with a

retro Pink Floyd-like delivery.

There are some interesting bridges tying the songs together-which is apropos for most concept albums. But don't let "concept album" scare you away-this is a Styx album that's filled with songs that can stand alone as great tracks by themselves.

Fans of the band will be very happy with this album-was it is worth waiting 12 years for? For the most part yes, and by the way-the album's cover artwork is amazing.
