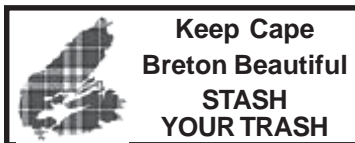

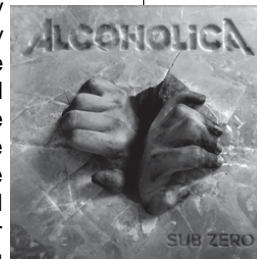

AlcoholicA - "Sub Zero" - Just a warning folks-things are gonna get very heavy-as in Heavy Metal. Fans of the band Metallica will be familiar with the phrase "alcoholica"-it's the nickname the band earned for their excessive drinking during the early days. It is also the name of a tribute band from here in Canada, and this is their album.



The band consists of Pierre St Jean (lead Singer/guitarist), Chris Joly (lead Guitar), J-F (bass) and Sebastian (drums); the album opens up with the song "Mr. Pain" which does sound like an early-era Metallica song, and "Access Denied" sounds like Metallica when Dave Mustaine was still in the band, as does the song "Beer 'em All". Best yet is the instrumental track "Lifer", which could easily slip onto one of Metallica's first 2 albums-it has a great melodic guitar sound and thundering drums on overload. Another stand-out track is "How Far Is Far Enough", which captures the guitar sound from Metallica's "And Justice For All" album to a T. It is a heavy song driven by the best elements of Thrash Metal (always my favourite genre of Heavy Metal). However, on songs like "The Last Of Us",

"For Those Who Left" and "Master Plan" the band sounds like Slipknot meets Disturbed-not bad company to be in!

The album closes off with a truly bizarre and oh-so enjoyable version of Elvis Presley's "Can't Help Falling In Love" and the only other way to describe it is to imagine Metallica backing up Elvis-again-weird but so freaking good.

On the band's website and Facebook page it says "The success of the AlcoholicA experience is a word of mouth achievement, the bands only promotional tool. AlcoholicA has shared the stage with multi platinum selling artists including Limp Bizkit, Bad Religion, The Offspring, Anti-Flag, Pennywise, Good Charlotte, Three Days Grace, just to name a few... Many of these well-known artists praised and expressed sincere gratitude towards the band's solid live performances. The members of AlcoholicA not only embody the music note for note but this band also retains the intensity and the magic of every song.
